Earlier this morning, it was reported to the administrators at our Jr-Sr High School that there was a man behaving erratically on Moriches-Middle Island Road, south of the entrance to the Jr-Sr High School. The report indicated that the man was jumping into the road in front of the automobiles, spitting on some of the cars and menacing the drivers.

Our Jr-Sr HS administration immediately notified the SCPD.

Our security staff was also informed of the report and they mobilized to secure the front entrance to our Jr-Sr High School, as well as the overall school grounds. Out of an abundance of caution for student and staff safety Mr. Alaimo, our Jr-Sr High School Principal, determined that the building should operate under a "Lockout" emergency protocol. This protocol restricts movement outside of the building and no one is permitted into or out of the school building. Classes continue and students/staff are freely able to move about the building during a "Lockout".

The police soon arrived to investigate the report. They provided the Jr-Sr HS administration with an update to the situation. An officer informed the administration that they are aware of the man and are currently addressing the situation. The Lockout was then ended.

Our security will maintain a security patrol at all of our outside campus entry points for the remainder of the day at the Junior-Senior High School.

We are grateful for the quick response and vigilance of our the officers in the SCPD.
