Friendship Ambassadors

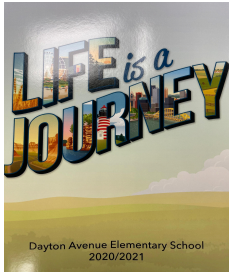
Friendship Ambassadors will work together to forge relationships between students, welcome new entrants, and ensure that our school is a friendly, welcoming, inclusive environment for all.
