

Law Day 2025 Poster Contest

Grades 2-8



The Law Day theme for 2025,
as set by the American Bar Association is:
“The Constitution's Promise: Out of Many, One.”

The Constitution enshrines our collective responsibility to one another, and the 2025 Law Day theme urges us to take pride in a Constitution that bridges our differences to bring us together as a united nation. Our civic lives tie us together as one “We,” whether through legislative efforts that serve the common good, through military service, or by working together, every day, to fulfill the promise of **E pluribus unum**, or **“Out of many, one.”**

Entrants will create a poster (drawing, painting, mixed media, etc.) that reflects this year’s theme. Prizes will be given for first, second, and third place on May 5th at 6 pm at the Suffolk County Bar Association (SCBA) Annual Meeting. Winners will be notified in advance of the meeting via email so that they know to attend the meeting.

- Entrants must be in grade 2-8 in Suffolk or Nassau County
- Entry must be the student’s original work
- Poster can be black and white or color
- Any expenses are the responsibility of the entrant
- Entries must be received no later than April 1, 2025
- By entering, the student/parent/guardian give SCBA the right to reproduce material submitted in any medium without time, use, or territorial limitation for non-commercial purposes
- Posters may be displayed at the Suffolk County Bar Association and in Suffolk County Courthouses
- Poster maximum size: 24in x 32in
- All entries should be submitted by email to LawDaySCBA@gmail.com. The email should contain a photo of the poster and a completed entry form, signed by the student’s parent or guardian
