As the calendar moves towards June, we are beginning the process of classroom/student placement for the 2025-2026 school year. Student placement is made with careful consideration, incorporating input from classroom teachers and support staff who work with your child. As we go through this process, one of our main goals is to structure our classes heterogeneously. This includes a number of variables to ensure that each section is balanced. Factors that contribute to planning are:

- The learning styles of individual students
- Recommendations from the current grade-level team and support staff

We have confidence in our approach to classroom placement and your perspective is an important part of that method. We will not accept requests for specific teachers. We do however believe that it is very important for you to provide information pertinent to your child's academic and social/emotional profile to support our team throughout the class placement process.
