Our school continues to implement a whole-school transformational process called the Leader in Me, which teaches 21st-century leadership and life skills to students and creates a culture of student empowerment based on the idea that every child can be a leader. Each Spring, a Measurable Results Assessment (MRA) is administered to help us set goals for the upcoming school year as well as to learn more about key areas of strength and areas of needed growth in our schools. The data from these surveys will also help us track the impacts of the Leader in Me process and implement key practices more fully. For us to have a holistic picture of what is going on in our school, we are asking all full-time staff members and parents/guardians to participate. **The survey will be open from today June 4th through June 25th.**

Parent Participation

If you decide to participate, you will be asked to complete a survey that will be available through a Web link that can be found below. While the survey is completely voluntary, we do hope to get feedback from at least one member of every household in order to gather the necessary information for us to continue to grow. If you do not have access to the Internet or a computer, we will have paper copies available for you in the main office. The parent/guardian survey takes about 10 minutes to complete and will ask questions about your child and about his or her experience in our school. If you have more than one child attending the school, you will be asked to think about the oldest child's experiences as you answer questions related to his or her growth.
