Dear Eastport-South Manor Colleagues, Families, and Staff,

On the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month of 1918, the Allied nations and Germany declared an armistice, effectively ending the major hostilities of World War I. The following year, President Woodrow Wilson declared that November 11th would be commemorated as Armistice Day. On June 4, 1926, Congress passed a resolution that the "recurring anniversary of November 11, 1918, should be commemorated with thanksgiving and prayer and exercises designed to perpetuate peace through good will and mutual understanding between nations" and that the President should issue an annual proclamation calling for the observance of Armistice Day. In 1954, following World War II and the Korean War, President Dwight Eisenhower signed legislation formally designating the day as Veterans Day; a day to honor all Americans who have served in the military during both wartime and peacetime. This year, we once again commemorate this national holiday.

Unfortunately, the true meaning of this national holiday is often forgotten, becoming merely a day off from work for adults and school for our children. As a school community, we should not permit this to happen. There are millions of veterans throughout our country who have sacrificed a great deal to ensure that America preserves the freedoms that we enjoy and, all too frequently, take for granted. At a time when brave American soldiers are fighting for our safety around the globe, let us take time to honor our veterans. We should also be sure that we pass the importance of this along to the next generation. I ask that teachers and parents discuss with our children the many sacrifices these heroic men and women have made to keep our nation safe. A kind deed or even a simple word of thanks to a veteran would lift their spirits and teach our children a truly valuable lesson.
