Dear ESM Parents/Guardians and Students:

Please refer to the information listed below regarding the Scheduling Process for the 2026-2027 school year.

We are currently engaged in planning our student schedules for our next academic year. At this time, we are asking our students and families to review our Course Catalog, as well as their current placements, and determine the academic courses that most align and interest each of our students. Our Course Catalog is attached as well as posted on the Junior-Senior High School website and can be accessed underneath "Important Links." The Course Catalog includes descriptions of course offerings, pathways and advancement within each department and an overview of New York State Commencement requirements.

Once students and families have discussed their intentions for the 2026-2027 school year, we are asking each student and/or parent/guardian to log into Infinite Campus. You will then have the choice to make course request selections by clicking on the course registration tab located on the left-hand side (under "More"). You should click on the 2026-2027 Course Registration Enrollment arrow and then be able to add courses. Parents/guardians and students will have the opportunity to search through courses and select course requests by clicking on the plus (+) sign and choosing to make it a request or alternate request (Once complete, click back to review all requests). Students are encouraged to select their core and elective courses they would like to be enrolled in during the 2026-2027 school year. It is important to select multiple course elective options during this process in order to ensure schedules are filled, therefore we encourage students to have alternate requests selected. Please note that 72 units are allowed to be selected which equals our nine-period day, but alternate requests do not count against the 72 units. Lunch and Physical Education (except Adventure Ed.) are already included for all students. All course request selections for next year must be submitted by **Friday, January 23, 2026**.

Beginning January 27<sup>th</sup> the counseling staff will meet with students, to discuss next year's courses. During this meeting, students will verify the information submitted online and have the opportunity to discuss their academic course selections.

Throughout the spring, the high school staff will work to create the master schedule. Please realize that the courses in the Course Catalog are listed on a tentative basis. As the spring progresses, counselors will meet with students to resolve any scheduling conflicts. Please be advised that for a variety of reasons, including, but not limited to: low student interest/enrollment, continuity of established programs, and shifts in building needs, not all

elective courses may run as offered during the course selection process. If a student selects an elective course that does not run, they will be placed in an alternate course of their choosing.
