Universal Pre-Kindergarten Program

Pending the approval of the NYS Budget, Eastport-South Manor Central School District will provide a half-day Universal Pre-Kindergarten at South Street School and Tuttle Avenue School for the 2019-2020 school year in cooperation with SCOPE Education Services. As the program is entirely funded through a grant from NYS, there are no additional costs to local taxpayers.

Universal Pre-Kindergarten Program and Application Details

Location: South Street School
Tuttle Avenue School

Staff: A NYS certified teacher and assistant

Days: Monday through Friday
(The program will follow the ESM 2019-2020 school calendar.)

Hours: Two 2.5 hour Morning Sessions, 8:30-11:00 a.m.
Two 2.5 hour Afternoon Sessions, 12:00-2:30 p.m.

Time preference will be considered, is not guaranteed, and based upon lottery results.
(Parents must provide transportation)

Eligibility: Applicants must be a resident, not eligible for Kindergarten until September 2020, and 4 years of age (born on or before December 1, 2015).

There are 54 openings. Students will be selected at a public lottery to be held on Tuesday, April 9, 2019 at 9:45 a.m. in the Library at South St. School. Successful applicants will then be contacted to complete the registration process.
