

ESM: Cleaning & Disinfecting



Daily Cleaning Procedures

The Eastport-South Manor School District has developed schedules and routines to augment its cleaning and disinfection protocols.

Classrooms, Laboratories & Offices

All Buildings: Each classroom and office will be cleaned and disinfected during the evening shift

Cafeterias

Elementary Schools: Students will eat lunch in classrooms with rooms cleaned after lunch and cleaned again during the night shift

Junior Senior High School: Cafeterias will be cleaned and disinfected after each lunch period and again during the night shift

Restrooms, Hallways & Lobbies

Each restroom, hallway and lobby will be cleaned and disinfected several times per day on a rotating basis, with a minimum of two times per day and again during the night shift

High-Touch Points

Multiple cleaning of door handles, light switches, counter tops, tables, chairs, sinks, hand sanitizer dispensers, computers, telephones among other points of concern will be done daily



Cleaning Enhancements

The Eastport-South Manor School District has upgraded its equipment and procedures to combat COVID-19

New Cleaning Tools

The District will deploy foggers and electrostatic sprayers to disinfect more surfaces thoroughly and faster

Air Quality

The District is working to install hospital-grade air filters in its HVAC systems where possible

Increasing Student Awareness

The District is placing hundreds of signs around the District to remind students to wash their hands, keep socially distant and to wear a mask.

Increased Access to Hand Sanitizer

In addition to each classroom having hand sanitizer, multiple points in hallways and entrance ways have added hand sanitizing points

Accountability

Checklists that document daily cleaning tasks will be posted in each classroom and restroom so students and staff can review for completeness
