\*\*Children ages five to eleven currently enrolled in a full-time self-contained special education class are eligible. Child must have completed kindergarten. Students receiving only Resource Room and/or Speech Services do not qualify for this program. Child must have a current IEP.

\*\*Child must reside in the Town of Brookhaven.

\*\*Camp begins Monday July 1, 2019 and ends Friday August 2, 2019

\*\*Camp is located at Holtsville Ecology Site

\*\*Pre-registration will not guarantee your child a place in the program. Acceptance is on a first come-first serve basis. Previous enrollment in the program does not guarantee your child placement this year. No exceptions!!! The program is limited. The waiting list will also be generated on a first come-first serve basis. You will receive written notification of your acceptance or waiting list status. No phone or faxed pre-registrations are accepted. Please mail or drop off pre-registration.

**\*\*Program runs Monday through Friday, 9AM to 12noon at Holtsville Ecology Site located at 249 Buckley Rd, Holtsville.**

**\*\*NO TRANSPORTATION PROVIDED\*\***

**\*\*Activities include swimming, arts and crafts, organized games and exercise time. Program participants swim everyday. The pool is an extensive part of our program. Participants are not allowed in the deepest end of the larger pool or on the diving boards. Certified lifeguards are always on duty. Locker rooms are available for changing but not locker space. Participants must carry their belongings. If your child is not interested in going in the pool, please reconsider registering for the program.**

**\*\*All participants MUST be completely toilet trained.**

**\*\*Physical disabilities need to be discussed on an individual case basis. Please call for more information.**

If you are accepted:

You will receive further information and an application that must be filled out. Your child is not accepted until the application is received, reviewed and accepted. You will receive written notification that your child has been accepted.

Please **DO NOT** send any money now. When you send in your full application, there will be a \$85.00 non-refundable camp fee.

**\*\*Learning disabled students are eligible for this program, however, if your child only has a learning problem and can handle him or herself socially, then we suggest enrollment in a different program. This program will accept all disabled students ranging from developmentally disabled or delayed, including Downs Syndrome and Autistic, to Learning Disabled. It is not a one-to-one ratio of counselor to participant. We are not able to accommodate severely disabled children. There are other programs that may be more appropriate for your child. We reserve the option to remove children from this program that may have severe behavior problems or may pose a danger to other children.**
