BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent that the Board of Education authorizes the funding of the Unreserved Undesignated Fund Balance in an amount not to exceed 4% of the 2011-2012 budget as authorized by law. Said amount will be funded from transfers from other reserves as permitted by law, designated fund balance and appropriations remaining from the 2010-2011 budget.

**Adjustment & Reduction of Fund Balance and Reserve Accounts**
