REPORTS/ANNOUNCEMENTS - SUPERINTENDENT

The Superintendent reported on the following:

- There is a teacher orientation next week for the newly appointed faculty.
- Superintendent's Conference Day is Thursday, August 29th and the first day of school is September 3rd.
- The Kiwanis Club is providing each third grader in the district with a dictionary. Thank you to Michelle Beardsley who helped make this possible.
- The following letter is being emailed to faculty, staff and parents and will be on the website regarding test scores:

Dear Parents:

Within the next few days, you will receive your child's results from the latest ELA and Math Assessment Exams for grades 3-8. District-wide scores are already available on the State Education Department website and have been widely publicized in the media.

This year's tests were unlike any assessment exams conducted in the past, as they were aligned with new, more rigorous Common Core Standards. As such, it is impossible to accurately compare student progress using prior year's assessment results.

Further, I find these "new baseline" scores to be erroneous and misleading. The Common Core curriculum is still in its early stages of implementation, and I believe that the new assessments were prematurely administered before students could be effectively instructed in the more challenging standards.

In his letter to parents, Commissioner King explains that "the change in test scores (including, possibly, one in your child's score) does not mean that students are learning less or that teachers and schools are performing worse than last year." It is important to reiterate this point; our students should not be discouraged by their results on these exams.

According to the State, the new Common Core Standards are intended to make our students more college and career ready by the time they graduate. I support this cause, but I find no correlation between these latest assessment results and our students' ability to be college and career ready. In fact, numerous other indicators confirm that our students are performing at a high academic level. For example, the ESM Class of 2013 graduated this past spring with over 95% receiving Regents Diplomas, and 92% of graduates will attend colleges and universities this fall. Our graduates also received over \$10 million in scholarships and awards, a reflection of their academic ability as well as their overall character and determination.

We have a strong academic program here at ESM, and these latest assessment scores do not reflect the success that takes place in our classrooms. Our educators are committed to providing the best possible educational program to help our students meet and exceed standards set by the State. We will continue to develop and implement new curricula that is aligned with the Common Core Learning Standards, and I am confident that future results will once again demonstrate our students' ability to succeed not only on these exams, but also in college and in the workplace.
