

**MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL MEETING  
EASTPORT SOUTH MANOR CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT  
MAY 21, 2013**

The Annual Meeting of the taxpayers of the Eastport South Manor Central School District was held May 21, 2013. The polls were officially opened by the District Clerk at 6:00 A.M. At the close of the voting at 9:00 p.m., the District Clerk read the results to the voters. The results were as follows:

**PROPOSITION NO. 1**

RESOLVED, that the proposed budget of expenditures of the Eastport-South Manor Central School District for the school year 2013-2014 in the amount of \$91,239,354.00, and for the purposes shown in the statement of estimated expenditures adopted by the Board of Education, be and the same hereby is approved and the amount thereof shall be raised by a levy of a tax upon the taxable property of the school district, after first deducting the monies available from State Aid and other sources as provided by law.

**PROPOSITION NO. 2**

Shall the Board of Education direct the transfer of excess funds in the amount of \$2,369,025.50 from the Liability Reserve Fund to the Retirement Contribution Reserve Fund for the purpose of paying required retirement contributions to the New York State and Local Employees' Retirement System in accordance with its authority to do so pursuant to the terms of Education Law § 1709(8-c) and General Municipal Law § 6-r?

**PROPOSITION NO. 3**

To authorize the Board of Education, for the purpose of enabling the residents of the Eastport South Manor Central School District to have the benefit of full library services, to enter into a contract with the Suffolk Cooperative Library System for library services for each resident to be provided by either the Westhampton Free Library, Mastics-Moriches-Shirley Library or the Riverhead Free Library or the Center Moriches Free Library for the period of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014 and to expend therefore during the District's fiscal year 2013-14 a sum of money not exceeding \$2,450,100.00 and that the Board of Education be authorized to levy the necessary tax therefore.
