- Tuttle Avenue Elementary School is still on target to open September, 2013.
- A huge thank you to all of the custodians in the district who worked tirelessly to get all of the schools looking brand new for the first day of school.
- Opening day went smoothly in all schools.
- Thank you to Mr. Gleason for bringing to our attention the need of donations for the food pantry in the William Floyd School District. This district is less fortunate than we are and a big percentage of the families are at the poverty level. If you would like to donate, boxes are at the schools until Friday.
- NYS has declared that all schools in the district are designated as In Good Standing.
